



How to register for Internet Banking.

1. Go to WWW.SHARONBANK.COM and click "[First Time Users](#)" link.
2. Fill out the online registration. Print and sign the registration form.
3. Either mail the form to:

4. You will receive a welcome letter in the mail containing your assigned Access Key and a copy of the Internet Disclosure.
5. Have ready your Social Security number and your Telephone Banking password.
6. Go to WWW.SHARONBANK.COM and click the Internet Banking link. You will be presented with the Sharon Savings Bank Welcome screen.
7. Enter your Social Security Number and your telephone banking password and click the "Enter" button.
8. Enter your Assigned Access Key when prompted.
9. Read the disclosure and agree or disagree. If you disagree, you will be unable to continue to login to Internet Banking.

How to register for online bill payment.

1. Go to WWW.SHARONBANK.COM and login to online banking Main Menu.
2. Click "Bill Payment," then "Click Here To Register"
3. Review the Terms and Conditions, then click "OK".
4. Fill out the application completely.
5. Click "Submit". Within 1-3 days, you will receive an email confirming your bill payment service is active.

How to check your account balance.

1. Go to WWW.SHARONBANK.COM and login to online banking Main Menu.
2. Click the “Account Access” button, to see a list of all your accounts and their corresponding balances.
3. Click the Account Title for your accounts to view transaction history.

How to transfer money between accounts.

1. Go to WWW.SHARONBANK.COM and login to online banking Main Menu.
2. Click the “Account Access” button, then click the “Transfer” button.
3. Enter the amount you want transferred, choose the accounts you want to transfer funds from and to, then click the “Transfer Funds” option.
4. Verify your transfer and click the “Confirm Transfer” option.
5. Print a copy of the transaction for your records.

IMPORTANT SECURITY INFORMATION

Most likely you’ve seen them: email messages asking you to verify personal information over the Internet.

The scam, popularly called ‘phishing,’ involves the use of replicas of existing Web pages to try to deceive you into entering personal, financial or password data. Often suspects use urgency or scare tactics, such as threats to close accounts.

We here at Sharon Savings Bank will never ask you via email to verify account information. We will never use email to threaten account closure. Please know this, as one defense against phishing. Other safeguards to help protect you from phishing scams:

- Be suspicious of any email messages that claims to be from us that use an urgent or scare-tactic tone.
- Do not respond to email messages asking you to verify personal information.



- Delete suspicious email messages without opening them. If you do open a suspicious email message, so not open any attachments or click any links.
- Install and regularly update virus protection software.
- Keep your computer operating system and Web browser current.

If you see a suspicious-looking email message claiming to be from Sharon Savings Bank, please let us know. We continually monitor such reports and act on them promptly. Additionally, also consider contacting the FBI's Internet Fraud Complaint Center at www.ifccfbi.gov.
